Authority

- Section 903, Duncan Hunter, National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year 2009

Duties

- The Corrosion Control and Prevention Executive Shall:
 - Ensure that corrosion control and prevention is maintained in the Army's policy and guidance.
 - Be responsible for identifying the funding levels necessary to accomplish the Army's program.
 - In cooperation with the appropriate Army staff, develop, support and provide the rationale for resources
 - Be the principal point of contact for the Army to the Director of corrosion Policy and Oversight in USD(AT&L)
 - Submit an annual report, NLT December 31 of each year, to the Secretary of Defense.



Areas of Concentration

- System Acquisition and Production, including design and maintenance.
- Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation programs and activities.
- Equipment standardization programs, including international standardization agreements.
- Logistics research and development initiatives.
- Logistics support analysis as it relates to integrated logistics support in the materiel acquisition process.
- Military infrastructure design, construction, and maintenance.
